


Folded Pen Adventures

Carol was Director of the 1987 and 1991 International Calligraphy Conferences held in Portland, and Co-Directed Calligraphy Northwest in 2012.

Student Supply List

Folded Pen – I recommend any of the following Folded Pens:

Horizon Folded Pen (my favorite!) – Available at Paper & Ink as a nib only or as a pen

Luthis Libelula – Available at John Neal Books

Tim's Pen – Radius or Mini Radius – available at John Neal Books

Folded Ruling Pen (N30) – John Neal Books

OPTIONAL: I like the Radius Cut Pilot Parallel Pens that JNB sells. I find they work quite well for smaller writing. I suggest you have one of the folded pens from the list above also.

Ink – Non-waterproof ink like Higgins Eternal, Walnut ink.

Capitol Bond layout paper 11x17, plain without grids – available in Portland at Columbia Art and online at John Neal Books . The 8 1/2"x11" size is also okay. This is simply the BEST paper for calligraphy practice. If you want to use another paper, be sure it works well with your ink.





Radius-cut Pilot Parallel Pen (Modified)
